The Department of Hematology at Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital is seeking a **Locum Hematologist** for up to 6 months starting approximately June 1, 2017. Our hematology department provides care for all hematologic malignancies as well as benign diagnoses. Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital is a new state-of-the-art, 1.6 million sq. ft. full-service acute care community hospital located in Oakville, Ontario (30 minutes west of Toronto or 20 minutes east of Hamilton).

The successful candidate will be expected to provide 2.5 days of hematology/oncology clinic coverage and participate in the inpatient consultation/call service rota. Our hospital has a robust hospitalist program to support inpatient care. The candidate would also have the option of participating in additional benign hematology clinics if desired.

Candidates must have an independent license or eligible for independent license with the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO). They must have fellowship standing in the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada (FRCPC) in Internal Medicine and have completed additional training in Hematology.
