

Looking For a Benign Hematologist

North York General Hospital is looking to hire a benign hematologist to join our Medical Oncology and Hematology division. We are a community teaching hospital, affiliated with the University of Toronto, located in the heart of North York at Highway 401 and Leslie.

We currently have two hematologists practicing both benign and malignant hematology and one medical oncologist/hematologist. We are interested in adding a benign hematologist to our group.

The job scope would include an outpatient practice as well as participation in our active hematology inpatient consult service, and the medical oncology/hematology call system. Patients with malignant disease seen in consultation would be transferred to one of the other hematologists. The benign hematologist would also have access to our Medical Surgical clinic for procedures, transfusions, iron infusions, etc.

North York General Hospital has one of the busiest surgical oncology services in the LHIN as well as an extremely active joint replacement program. This would provide an excellent opportunity to enhance the thromboprophylaxis for complex inpatients. Additionally, interested candidates could take over the role of transfusion consultant for our blood bank.

Other hospital activities would include our bimonthly hematology pathology rounds. We are affiliated with University of Toronto and have a very large family medicine residency program at our hospital. There are ample opportunities for teaching family medicine residents as well as clinical clerks. There can be opportunities for inpatient internal medicine as well.

North York General Hospital is a lovely place to work. Our division is extremely collegial and this extends beyond our division to the entire staff (physicians, nurses, allied health, etc.) .
