

Haematology Position at Southlake Regional Health Centre Newmarket, ON

This locum position will be available from July 1, 2017. The position is initially a maternity locum for 9-12 months. We are planning to convert this to a permanent position going forward. It is possible that the candidate filling this locum might stay on as a full time haematologist at Southlake.

Southlake is a large community and teaching hospital in Newmarket, Ontario (25 minutes north of Toronto). There are presently 4 haematologists who work with the larger department of medicine to provide care for inpatients as well as the outpatient catchment population. We provide services in the Cancer Centre as well as benign consultative services through ambulatory clinics supported by the Department of Medicine.

The locum will include clinic time in both the cancer centre and the hospital. An office and support services are available for this locum.

This is a great opportunity for an individual to practice with the support of many colleagues. The role for expanding the benign hematology practice and staying on as a permanent member of the Department of Medicine can be explored from the vantage of starting as a locum. We do see a need to grow our benign consultative practice and thromboembolism program given the large and diverse clinical programs at Southlake. These include a comprehensive cardiac program, maternofetal medicine program, a broad surgical program (including cardiac surgery) and of course a large and growing medicine program.
