

Hematology locum St. Michael's Hospital

A Hematology locum is requested for a nine month maternity leave (length negotiable) from April 17, 2017 to February 1, 2018 with the Division of Hematology and Medical Oncology at St. Michael's Hospital. This tertiary care 650 bed hospital affiliated with the University of Toronto is a regional trauma centre, a centre of excellence for four critical care units, and is fully supported with all subspecialty general medicine services including hemodialysis and apheresis.
