MEDICAL ONCOLOGY, APP POSITION

The Dr Douglas A MacIntosh Cancer Clinic in partnership with The Cancer Centre of South-eastern Ontario (CCSEO) are searching for a Medical Oncologist.

This 1.0 FTE position is fully funded by MOH as a ONT MOA APP position with competitive salary.

You will have the unique opportunity to work in the Cancer Clinic of a community Hospital in Belleville and at the CCSEO, an Academic, Queen`s University based tertiary care Regional Cancer Centre , in Kingston. Both offering new state of the art clinics and separated by only 45 minutes on the 401.

You will observe early on the collegiality of all the staff and the excellent working atmosphere this position provide. You will be an integral member of our team with input on decisions regarding tumour site management, clinical operations and scheduling. The majority of your clinical work will be at the Dr Douglas A MacIntosh Cancer Clinic where you will join a team of 2 full-time and 1 part-time medical oncologists. You will have access to a dedicated team of pharmacists, a strong experienced nursing support staff and excellent administrative bodies. We are a Level 3 Cancer Center offering treatment to cancer types that are appropriate for a community cancer clinic.

Radiation treatment is provided at the CCSEO . Your appointment at the CCSEO does provide the opportunity to continue active care of your patients in Kingston managing their chemotherapy while they get radiation concurrently. You will be a member of the Clinical Trial Program at the SEORCC and participate in the recruitment as well as follow up of those patients on clinical studies. At present, 20% of our Quinte patients with lung cancer are involved in clinical studies. You will have an academic appointment of Assistant Professorship in the Department of Medical Oncology and Internal Medicine at Queen`s University. With this, comes a commitment to engage in clinical education and training of medial students, residents and fellows.

The Dr Douglas A MacIntosh Cancer Clinic at Quinte Health Care is located within Belleville General Hospital. Quinte Health Care is a four site hospital corporation that provides primary and secondary services to a diverse catchment area of approximately 160,000 people in the Hasting, Prince Edward Counties and the Southeast portion of Northumberland County.

The Belleville General Hospital is situated on the shore of the Bay of Quinte. This region offers desirable waterfront and affordable lifestyle.
