The Leukemia/Bone Marrow Transplantation Program of British Columbia offers 1 or 2 Year fellowships to provide advanced training in the management of adults with hematological malignancies including all aspects of allogeneic and autologous hematopoietic stem cell transplantation (HSCT). Approximately 240 HSCT procedures are carried out per year and 125-150 patients with acute leukemia are referred to the program each year. The fellowship offers extensive clinical experience and affords plenty of research opportunities in malignant hematology and stem cell transplantation. Candidates should be registered in, or completed a recognized hematology or oncology training program. Salary: \$70,000/annum plus benefits.
