There are opportunities to focus on many aspects of non-complex-malignant hematology, including early MPNs, early LPDs, and investigation and management of cytopenias, providing ambulatory support to the wider UHN patient population with hematological complications. Interested individuals may wish to consider pursuing an academic tract as clinical associate/lecturer with divisional support for additional training and certification where desired, with a view to career development. Effective start date is September 1, 2017, or shortly thereafter.

The position is well suited to early career physicians with advanced training in thrombosis. The successful candidate will work alongside a multidisciplinary team (MDs, NPs, RNs) in Canada's first and largest comprehensive thrombosis clinic, and will continue to provide excellence in care and scholarly activity. The candidate will join the general hematology consult call schedule. The candidate will be mentored by senior staff to develop an academic interest in clinical research, education or quality improvement. Additional qualifications in the relevant domain are required.

The successful candidate must hold an MD degree, be eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Hematology, and have, or be eligible for licensure in Ontario. A highly attractive remuneration package is available.
