Mackenzie Health is pleased to announce a full-time position for a benign hematologist.

The Hospital

Mackenzie Health is a regional healthcare organization that is rapidly expanding to meet the needs of the growing community of Southwest York region. The current Mackenzie Richmond Hill Hospital is a large community hospital located in Richmond Hill. It is a 515 bed facility serving a population of greater than 500,000. It is a district stroke and regional dialysis centre. Construction of a second site, Mackenzie Vaughan Hospital is underway, with tentative opening planned for 2019.

The Position

The successful candidate will join a collegial, dedicated team consisting of 2 full-time medical oncologists, and 1 full-time benign/malignant hematologist. Training and interest in thromboembolic disease and management would be an asset.

Hospitalists are the primary care physicians for the hematology inpatients, and hematology provides consultant opinion and management when needed.

Although the candidate's focus would be benign hematology, he or she would be expected to consult on and initiate investigations for malignant hematology cases.

There is no requirement for internal medicine call, but the selected candidate would be required to round on a third of the medicine ward patients, approximately one weekend every 2-3 months.

Support from Laboratory, Pathology, Diagnostic Imaging and Interventional Radiology departments is readily available and wait times for reporting, imaging and procedures are reasonably short.
