This is a clinical position and responsibilities will include care of complex malignant hematology patients (autoSCT, CART, acute leukemia) as well as some general malignant hematology. Duties include attending in outpatient clinics, inpatient care, regional support and participation in on-call coverage. Program development, leadership and participation in quality and FACT accreditation is expected.
